

COVID-19 testing options.

As we continue to navigate the COVID-19 pandemic, MedStar Health remains committed to providing the most appropriate and timely access to urgent care and COVID-19 testing options for our patients. Below are recommendations which may help you choose a test option that best serves your needs safely.

Urgent care centers:

 All MedStar Health Urgent Care visits for COVID-19 exposure or symptomless testing (pre-operative, return to work, return to school) require you to save your spot online ahead of time. This allows us to streamline and space out the volume of patients throughout the day and follow physical distancing measures. If we do not have availability at your regularly preferred location, you can book for the next available date/time at that location or look for other locations nearby.

Primary care centers:

 If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and need to see a provider, many MedStar Health primary care locations are offering COVID-19 testing by appointment. <u>Access.MedStarHealth.org</u>

Drive-up or in-person testing options:

- Same day testing: Requires an appointment.

- Most local pharmacies have COVID-19 drive up testing options. Please visit their website or call for details.
- **State-based testing:** The following two sites are open 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., seven days a week. Walk-ups only (no appointments available):

 - Anne Arundel Medical Center: South Pavilion, 2001 Medical Pkwy., Annapolis, MD 21401
- **Departments of health:** Check with state and county Departments of Health for in-person and take-home tests at libraries, shopping malls, and other public locations.

At-home testing options:

• Following are companies that offer at-home polymerase chain reaction (PCR) COVID-19 testing options. Please check for minimum age requirements. Any patient can order these tests online and they will be shipped to your home within 24 hours*, with results often faster than our urgent care centers. Most insurance plans and FSA/HSA will cover these tests.
