Many older adults struggle to get to the doctor's office due to severe chronic illness and disability. The MedStar House Call team can help.

Our team of doctors, nurse practitioners (NPs) and social workers make house calls to ill and disabled elders. We bring skilled staff and modern technology to help them live with dignity and independence in their own homes.

Whom do we serve? People who:

- Are 65 years of age or older.
- Have difficulty getting to the doctor's office.
- Live in one of these Baltimore ZIP codes: 21206, 21210, 21211, 21212, 21213, 21214, 21218, or 21239.
- Have Medicare, Medicaid or other eligible insurance.

Our team offers home-based primary care and coordinates all medical and social services for people with advanced illness. We work closely with patients' previous primary care doctors to create a successful transfer to home-based medical care.

What services do we provide?

- Home-based primary care by physicians and NPs, including regular and urgent visits, with labs and X-rays done at home, as needed
- Coordination of social support services
- In-home counseling and caregiver support
- Home delivery of medicines and equipment
- Coordination of skilled home nursing, PT, OT, or hospice when needed
- On-call doctor or NP available by phone, 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Hospital care at MedStar Good Samaritan or Union Memorial hospitals
- Coordination of specialist doctors and any needed procedures
- Referral to community resources for meals, personal care aides, or financial assistance
