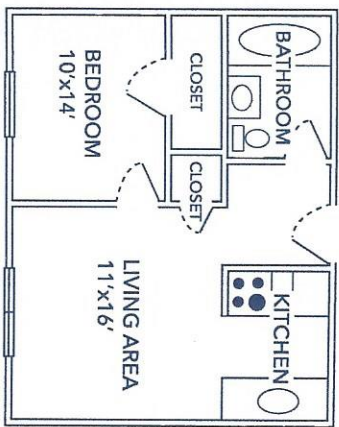
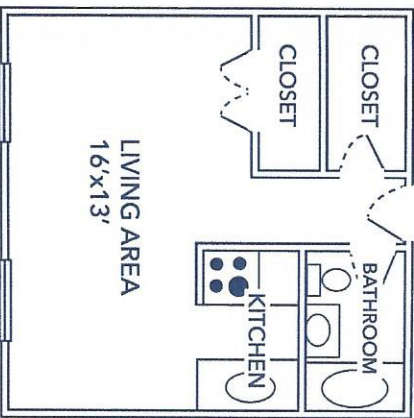

Spacious rent-subsidized apartments include all the services you would expect, as well as extra amenities.

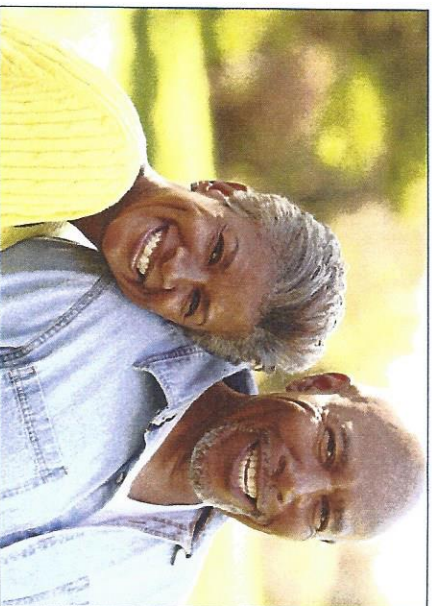
Because of the close affiliation with MedStar Good Samaritan, Belvedere Green and Woodbourne Woods residents can also depend on expert medical care right next door.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- At least 62 years of age
- Handicapped/disabled
- Able to live independently without assistance
- Meet HUD income limits

**RENT: AN EQUAL HOUSING OPPORTUNITY**

- All units are rent subsidized.
- Residents pay only 30 percent of adjusted gross income.

**SUPPORT SERVICES:**

The MedStar Good Samaritan Hospital Senior Supportive Services program is a package of services offered to the residents of Belvedere Green and Woodbourne Woods apartments.

The program is designed to assist residents that may experience periodic difficulty with the essential activities of daily living. To gain complete information about an applicant's areas of need, it is requested that the applicant participate in a psychosocial assessment and receive a current medical evaluation from a physician.

The goal of the Senior Supportive Services program is to allow residents to continue living in an independent setting by providing personalized support services, ensuring proper nutrition, encouraging socialization, and assisting with regular monitoring of health and medical conditions.

**INDIVIDUALIZED SERVICES INCLUDE:**

- Two meals a day, seven days a week, served in the dining room
- A minimum of 1.5 hours of housekeeping each week, which includes vacuuming, dusting, mopping, etc.
- A minimum of 1.5 hours of personal care each week, which includes assistance with bathing, dressing and grooming as needed
- A minimum of 1.5 hours of laundry service each week

The maximum monthly cost of the program is based upon income as determined by the State Office on Aging. The fee may be subsidized by the Maryland Office on Aging, depending on the participant's income. Exact program fees cannot be determined until all income information has been reviewed.
